On July 15, 2004 Dianne Wilkins and I, staff members of the Pollution Prevention and Customer Assistance Programs, visited your facility. Based on your description, our observations and the feedback provided by the Department's Land Protection Division, we have determined that you are presently in compliance with the applicable state and federal environmental rules and regulations. Your current processes generate no air emissions, no wastewater discharges, and you do not generate or store hazardous wastes. Your only waste stream going to disposal is broken plastic that is incinerated by the City of Tulsa.
